Transfer Oil activities are governed by the Code of Ethics decided and approved by the Board of Directors in compliance with the Sustainability Model envisaged in the United Nations Global Compact in 2004.

This is in firm compliance with and support of the "Universal Declaration of Human Rights", the "International Labour Organization's Declaration on Fundamental Principles and Rights at Work", the "Rio Declaration on Environment and Development" and the "United Nations Convention against Corruption".

- the compliance with applicable laws and industry standards on working hours and ensuring that wages shall be in adherence with legal guidelines and be sufficient to meet the basic needs of personnel.
- establishing and maintaining appropriate procedures to evaluate and select suppliers and subcontractors in consideration of their commitment to social and environmental accountability.
- the zero tolerance of all forms of corruption in any jurisdiction, even if such activities are allowed, tolerated or non-prosecutable.
- The involvement of all levels within its organisation and all employees in assuring that responsibilities and operating procedures are precisely defined, appropriately communicated and clearly understood.
